Is Your EZ Pass Operating Properly?

Recently one of our vans had a problem with their EZ Pass malfunctioning. Their EZ Pass was not being read by meters which resulted in ticketing. You can check to see if your EZ Pass is working properly by turning the HOV button off and then back to HOV on. If you hear a beeping sound coming from the device, it is working. If the device does not make a beeping sound, then it will need to be replaced immediately. If charges have been issued, due to a malfunctioning device, EZ Pass does offer a one-time forgiveness of all charges. If you have questions you can contact EZ Pass at 877-762-7824.

Fourth of July Travel Will Be the Highest on Record

AAA projects nearly 43 million Americans will travel this upcoming 4th of July weekend. This is the highest Independence Day travel volume on record and represents five million more travelers compared to our recent Memorial Day weekend.



Recent low gas prices are being cited as a reason so many will be traveling. Prices are the lowest they have been since 2005.

Drivers have saved about \$20 billion on gasoline so far this year compared to the same period in 2015. This has made travel more affordable than it has been in recent years. These low gas prices are causing more of an increase in auto travel. Eighty-four percent of travelers will drive to their destinations, an increase of 1.2 percent over last year. Air travel is expected to increase 2.2 percent over last year.

Travel by cruises, trains, buses, and other modes of transportation will increase two percent. Most of those travelers are expected to be traveling on cruise ships.

Should You Top Off Your Gas Tank?

When your gas pump nozzle shuts off are you one of those drivers that cannot resist the urge to top off their tanks? If so you are making a costly and dangerous mistake.

Gas pumps are equipped with an automatic shutoff, that keep gas from getting into the air. When you top off your tank, you are actually paying for gas that is drawn back into the gas station's vapor recovery system. In addition, the extra gas you are pumping could be drawn back through the vapor recovery system into the station's tanks. If this occurs, you are now paying for gas that is not even going into your car but is going into the gas station's tanks. This, is a waste of your money.

When you overfill your gas tank, gasoline evaporate or spills, especially in hot weather. This again leads to you purchasing gas that is not even getting into your car but is going into the environment. Hurting both our air and your wallet.

Gas expands as it gets warmer. Gas that is stored in the underground tanks is cooler than the air because the ground insulates it. As the fuel in your tank gets warmer it expands and must have more room. When you overfill your car, there is no room for the fuel to expand or go anywhere. It then can find its way into the vapor collection system of your own car. This can damage your vapor system. Expanding gas is lost fuel that you have paid for. But that is not the end it, if the expanding fuel ends up in your car's vapor collection system, your vehicle will become much less efficient and may burn more fuel.

Finally, gas vapors add toxic substances into the air. These vapors can be harmful to you if inhaled and harmful to the environment.
