DC Drivers the Worst in Our Country?

Recently, an article was written in the Washington Post stating that DC Drivers were rated dead last in a study done by the insurance giant Allstate. For eight years Allstate has been collecting crash data from their policy holders in our nation's top 200 largest cities. According to their findings the average driver in the district goes a little over 4 years between accidents. In addition, they are 112% more likely to be involved in an accident than the national average. And don't think we are just picking on the District. Things don't look better if you are traveling in the metro area as a whole. In Baltimore you can expect to go just a little above 5 years before having an accident and in Alexandria and Arlington, VA try just a little above 6 years.

Since this is DC's 3rd straight year being named the worst in our country what better time to offer some quick safety reminders:

1. Since roads in the metro area are not always ideal, be mindful of construction and the possible delays that you may incur. Allow time for these delays so you will not be tempted to speed.
2. Drive defensively and know where you are going. Also, learn alternate routes to your destination.
3. Stay alert and keep your driving area free from distractions.

And in case you are wondering. The safest state was Sioux Falls, S.D where drivers can expect to go 13.8 years between crashes.
