Commute Times are On the Rise

According to a recently released 2017 American Community Survey, the Census Bureau reports that Americans are spending an extra 2.5 hours in transit as compared to 2016. However, the average commute only increased 18 seconds per trip.

Major cities were hit the hardest and the Washington metro area continues to be in the top 5 areas with the longest commute.

Commute times have been on the rise nationwide since 2010. There are multiple factors contributing to this increase in travel time. First, as people have moved more into the suburbs, jobs have also moved away from population centers and urban areas. Another factor is that the cost of living in major cities continues to rise. This forces people to move further out in order to find affordable housing. Also, in recent years car ownership has also increased leading to more vehicles on the road.

According to the survey, Washington's commute times went up to 34.9 minutes from 34.8 in 2016. This is a whole ½ minutes longer than in 2007. This accounts for DC commuters spending 12.5 more hours in traffic in 2017 compared to years past.

As a nation there are implications to the rise in commute times. These implications impact individual's health, family life, work habits, and more. Vanpooling continues to be a viable alternative to commuting alone, helping to ease congestion on the road and some of the personal effects of commuting.
